A collective subscription model that, through its membership scheme, makes library funds go further: achieving the dual objectives of increasing collections and supporting Open Access.



# The model in a nutshell

Library subscribes to backlist package of *non*-OA books offered by publisher



Package access is available to subscribing library only.

Publisher makes backlist package of *non*-OA books available to members only



Books in the subscription package remain non-OA.

Publisher uses subscription money to publish new OA books



OA books are made available to everyone.
